



Awards & Jacket Policy for Crestwood Curling Club

Updated as of October 1, 2026

1. Awards for Events Sanctioned by Curling Canada:

Policy Statement:

When there is a National event sanctioned by Curling Canada (ie. Juniors, Mixed, Women's, Men, Seniors, Masters, Clubs), members of the Crestwood Curling Club competing in a Provincial, or National event will receive awards from the Crestwood.

Guidelines:

- The team must represent the Crestwood Curling Centre.
- Recipients must be Crestwood League members in good standing.
- Spares and alternates are not eligible
- Direct Entry Events are not eligible
- If the team does not fully consist of Crestwood Members, the monetary amount will be prorated accordingly.
- Crestwood Junior Sponsored teams are also eligible for these Awards

Awards:

Event	If event is located within 100 km. of Edmonton	If event is located more than 100 km. from Edmonton
Provincial Event	\$200	\$400
National Event	\$400	\$800

*The Competition Committee will review all awards and requests and has final say on Awards. The spirit of curling and the Crestwood will be considered.



2. Awards for events Not Sanctioned by Curling Canada

Policy Statement:

When there is a National event not sanctioned by Curling Canada, members of the Crestwood Curling Club competing in a Provincial, or National event will receive awards from the Crestwood.

Guidelines:

- The team must represent the Crestwood Curling Centre.
- Recipients must be Crestwood League members in good standing.
- Spares and alternates are not eligible
- Direct Entry Events are not eligible
- If the team does not fully consist of Crestwood Members, the monetary amount will be prorated accordingly.
- Eligible Events:
 - Stick (Awards are based on a 4-person team, stick curling will receive 25% per member)
 - Police
 - Legion
 - 55+
- To obtain awards for an event, submit a request in writing with supporting information to the Board of Directors.

Awards:

Event	If event is located within 100 km. of Edmonton	If event is located more than 100 km. from Edmonton
Provincial Event	\$100	\$200
National Event	\$300	\$400

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3. Jacket Policy

Policy Statement:

Crestwood Teams/Members may be eligible to receive funds towards team jackets if they represent the Club at eligible events.

Eligible Events:

- Sanctioned events leading to a National:
 - Clubs – including Provincial Qualifier
- Non-sanctioned events:
 - City Championships

Guidelines:

- The team must represent the Crestwood Curling Centre.
- Recipients must be Crestwood League members in good standing.
- If a member has received a jacket award in the last 3 seasons, they are not eligible to receive another jacket award.
- This award must be used for Team Jackets or Cresting and the member must provide purchase receipts.
- A team is 4 persons (Stick Curling – 2 persons), jacket awards for alternates or spares will be at the team's own expense.
- A team may receive additional awards if they represent the Crestwood at more than one event.

Award:

- Each Member shall receive up to \$80.
- Each Member shall also receive a physical or digital copy of the Crestwood Logo.

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
