- No handshakes (greet each other with a socially distanced broom tap)
- Rock Handles will be sanitized daily, there will be sanitizing wipes available on all sheets

Off the Ice:

If you feel sick or have symptoms pertaining to COVID-19 please stay home.

Junior Curling:

Junior Curling and Little Rocks will proceed as usual this year.

Masks will be required for all curlers, coaches and volunteers on the ice. Masks are required as per the City of Edmonton Bylaw in the lobby and lounge unless seated eating and drinking.

Bar and Lounge:

The Crestwood Bar and Lounge will be OPEN!

Rapid Response Plan & Risk Avoidance Protocol:

Crestwood Curling Club will follow the guidance of AHS and comply with all rules and regulations in the event of an outbreak.
